6. Any other related duties assigned by the Project Manager.

#### **Qualifications & Competencies**

1. At least a first degree in Agriculture, Agronomy, Animal Husbandry, Veterinary Science or a related field ;
2. A minimum of three (3) years' practical experience and knowledge in working in the agricultural sector in Suriname;
3. Knowledge and experience in the implementation of large-scale agricultural projects;
4. Ability to handle multiple assignments simultaneously to meet goals and deadlines;
5. Good time management and organizational skills
6. Fluency in English and Dutch is required.
7. Proven ability to make effective use of computers and software programs, such as Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook) and social media technologies.
